

## **The 153rd International Senior Seminar**

### **“Treatment of Female Offenders”**

#### **1. Duration and Participants**

- From 9 January to 8 February 2013
- Fifteen overseas participants from twelve countries (including a Course Counsellor)
- Seven domestic participants

#### **2. Programme Overview**

Historically, the treatment of female offenders had not received much attention because of their relatively small population in comparison with male offenders. However, the population of female offenders is on the rise in many nations recently, which has increased the demand to enhance the treatment of female offenders. The adoption of the United Nations Rules for the Treatment of Women Prisoners and Non-custodial Measures for Women Offenders (the Bangkok Rules) by the United Nations General Assembly in December, 2010 indicates the international surge of such demands.

The objective of this Seminar is to offer participants an opportunity to share experiences, gain knowledge, and examine measures related to the treatment of female offenders. In order to achieve this purpose, the Seminar will provide an opportunity to examine the current situations and problems existing in the participants’ respective countries.

Major topics for discussion include:

- Status of female-committed crime;
- Issues related to the treatment of female offenders; and
- Female staff
