2. Programme Overview

From the perspective of stress management of correctional personnel, participants discussed what capacity is necessary for all mid-level staff to manage stress and how to enhance such capacity. The objective of this programme was to give criminal justice officials from the Asia and Pacific region, and other countries, an opportunity to share experiences, to gain knowledge, and to achieve the goals of the criminal justice system by enhancing the capacity of mid-level staff.
