Dr. Kittipong Kittayarak has long been involved in judicial and criminal justice reform in Thailand. He has made substantial contributions to the improvement of the Thai judicial system through his roles in a number of national bodies. He is well recognized as one of the champions for the reform of the Thai criminal justice system towards due process and the rule of law, and for pioneering the implementation of the restorative justice and community justice programs in Thailand.



After completing his six-year term as the Permanent Secretary for Justice and brief term as an Advisor to the Prime Minister, he assumed the Executive Director of the Thailand Institute of Justice (TIJ) in 2015, where he led research and capacity building activities. From April 2021, he has been serving as a Special Advisor to the TIJ.

Throughout his professional career, he has also been strongly committed to a vast range of activities which strengthened the relationship between Japan and Thailand in the field of justice. Through his outstanding contributions, he will be receiving the decoration “The Order of the Rising Sun, Gold and Silver Star” this fall.

He holds J.S.D. from Stanford Law School, LL.M. from Harvard Law School, barrister-at-law from The Thai Bar Association, LL.M. from Cornell Law School, and LL.B. from Chulalongkorn University, Thailand.
